IN APP STORE REVIEW · IN BETA

Your worst clients become your easiest.

Your landscaper clients will hand you a ZIP of named receipt photos and a CSV mapped to Schedule C lines instead of a shoebox.

CutCrew is the crew clock that runs a landscaping business's back office. The crew punches in on their phones, receipts get photographed at the register and categorized on the spot, and invoices get paid by link. At the close of a quarter the owner taps once, and the two files below land in your inbox.

EACH QUARTER, YOUR INBOX GETS

A file, not a shoebox.

GreenAcresLawn_2026-Q2_receipts.zip

Every approved receipt photo, filed by month and named by date, vendor, and amount.

A copy of the CSV rides inside the archive, so the ZIP stands on its own years later.

One row per receipt, eight columns:

```
date, vendor, description, amount, category,
schedule_c_line, payment_method, receipt_photo
```

Categories are assigned at the register rather than reconstructed in April, and each carries its Schedule C line. The last column holds that receipt's path inside the ZIP, so every row ties to its image.

WHAT IT COSTS YOUR CLIENT

Whole crew, flat	\$29/mo
Per-user fees	\$0
Crew sizes served	1-10

One price covers the whole crew. Adding the fourth employee costs the same as adding the first.

WHY IT HOLDS UP

Records lock at export

Once a quarter is sent, those receipts can no longer be edited. What you file from is what existed that day.

Corrections are logged

A fixed time entry is written as a new record carrying who changed it and when. The original stays readable.

Kept 7 years

Every export and the records behind it stay on file for seven years, including for crew who have left.

WHERE IT STANDS TODAY

CutCrew is in App Store review now — beta crews are running real weeks on it while Apple reviews. Beta testers get **90** days free when it ships, and nobody is billed during the beta; the standard trial after launch is **30** days. Put a client forward for the beta and ask about the **60**-day accountant-referral trial — there's no code to hand out, so write to the address below and we'll set it up.
